There has been a Reactivation of the Coleman Furnace Recall of 2004. This recall was for certain Coleman furnaces which were overheating and unsafe. If your furnace has the noted serial numbers, replacement or repair would be available for you. For more information about the recall, please come to the Vintage Acres office.

Creamy Chicken with Roasted Poblanos

3/4 C chicken broth 6oz cream cheese, softened 1 C pomegranate seeds, divided 1 whole chicken (3 lbs.), cut up



4 large poblano chilies (1 lb), peeled, seeded, and cut into strips

4 slices cooked ham, chopped

BLEND broth, cream cheese and 1/3 C pomegranate seeds in blender until smooth; strain.

COOK chicken in large skillet on med heat 10 min. or until evenly browned on both sides, turning occasionally. Add chilies and ham; cook 2 min.

STIR in cream cheese mixture; cover. Cook on mediumlow heat 15 min. or until chicken is done (165 degrees F)

TOP with remaining pomegranate seeds just before serving.

A. Yes. CO (Carbon Monoxide) detectors are inexpensive and can save your life. CO gas is colorless and odorless and has been given the name the "silent killer." You can find them at any hardware store for around \$20 They are easy to install and maintain. You should have one within 10 feet of your bedroom. Some homes need more than one detector.
